Greens Will:

- Ensure the Equality and Human Rights Commission regard homophobia, biphobia and transphobia as any other type of discrimination
- Ensure that commissioners and providers of public services meet the needs of LGBTIQ people
- Use employment laws and union support for the benefit of the LGBTIQ community
- Make full civil marriage available to same-sex partners and lobby other governments to recognise UK same-sex partnerships
- Ensure the provision of comprehensive sex education in schools, combat homophobic, biphobic and transphobic bullying, and provide a supportive environment for LGBTIQ students and staff
- Withdraw charitable status from discriminatory organisations and remove exemption from religious organisations
- Grant asylum to those fleeing LGBTIQ persecution
- Amend hate-crime legislation to outlaw inciteful music and media
- Require police forces to implement effective action plans to combat homophobic, biphobic and transphobic hate crimes
- Ensure the promotion of LGBTIQ Human Rights and counter violations internationally
