GREEN PARTY POLICIES FOR THE LGBT COMMUNITY

1. Ensure the proposed Commission for Equality and Human Rights address homophobia and transphobia on a par with all other forms of discrimination. 2. Extend employment protection legislation to include workers with religious employers. 3. Introduce legislation to protect LGBT people from discrimination in the provision of all goods and services - without exception. 4. Open up full civil marriage to same sex partners and lobby other governments to recognise UK same sex partnerships and marriages. 5. Ensure all schools provide sex education including on the diversity of sexualities and gender identities and create supportive environments for LGBT staff and students. 6. Increase funding for sexual health clinics and targeted health promotion work to combat HIV and other STIs. 7. Withdraw charitable status from discriminatory organisations. 8. Grant asylum to LGBT people fleeing homophobic or transphobic persecution. 9. Harmonise hate crimes legislation to outlaw the performance, sale, promotion and broadcasting of music and other arts which incite hatred and violence . 10. Require police forces to adopt and implement action plans on homophobic and transphobic hate crimes. 11. Ensure the UK Government adopts a policy on the promotion of LGBT human rights internationally and acts to help end LGBT human rights violations around the world.
